Trek jungle paths, kayak on the deep green rivers and explore the limestone caves in the hills or strike out on your own with the Lodge's all-terrain bikes. Blue Creek, Laguna and Tiger Caves are some of the better known destinations but more are being discovered all the time. Stop for lunch and a refreshing dip at one of the many



waterfalls. Snorkel, swim and watch for manatee and dolphin in the crystal clear waters on our trips to the offshore cays.



You will find howler monkeys, iguana, otter and turtles on river trips as well as the occasional crocodile if you're lucky. Kingfishers and herons, including the elusive Agami heron, can also be observed.

This most unspoiled and unexplored area of Belize is extraordinarily well-endowed with cultural and natural attractions and possibilities for adventure.

About The Lodge



Our intimate family run Lodge is set on the banks of the Rio Grande in Belize's southern Toledo District. The river winds around the property for almost a mile and each cabana looks down on its banks. You will love the ambience of comfort, elegance and tranquility.

The individual cottage style cabanas all have ensuite bathrooms with a window from the shower to your own enclosed garden. Each cabana is thatched with bay-leaf palm. Beautifully tiled floors, fans and fully screened, wood louvered windows offer a cool well-ventilated living area. Landscaping around the cabanas attract birds and butterflies and can be enjoyed from hammocks on your own thatched verandah.

Watch the sun set over the misty ridges of the Maya Mountains to the west before enjoying the fine food and wine in the Lodge's restaurant.



Tours & Activities

Mayan Culture

Visit traditional thatched Mayan homes: Try your hand at grinding corn and making tortillas; drink cacao like the Mayan kings of old. Listen to Mayan harp playing and learn some secrets of the medicinal rainforest plants. Visit the ancient Mayan site of Lubaantun where the Crystal Skull was discovered and Nim Li Punit famed for its stone stelae recording Mayan history in beautiful carved hieroglyphics.



Nature

Marvel at the profusion of birds, butterflies, orchids and bromeliads under the rainforest canopy. The Lodge itself has a variety of habitats including river bank, orchard, pastures and forest while other species abound in the jungle, cayes, estuaries and wetlands. Toledo has 490 species of which 370 have been recorded close to the Lodge.
